Y6 Open Day, and Open Evening - Monday 11 September 6.00 - 8.00pm

I am delighted to be able to invite you to our Open Evening for current Year 6 students. We are part of the Outwood Grange Family of Schools – named last year in the Price Waterhouse Cooper research for The Times as the highest performing multi-academy trust (MAT) in the country. Outwood Academy Bydales has been open now for three years and outcomes for our students are outstanding and have been record breaking year on year. Our goal is simple, we believe that:

“The whole point of schools is that children come first and everything we do must reflect this single goal. Students First: Raising Standards and Transforming Lives”

This vision is helping us to ensure that Outwood Academy Bydales is committed to providing an outstanding educational experience, allowing all our students to achieve their potential. In 2015, at the end of our first year of opening, the school was placed in the top 3% of similar schools, this being the highest position within the Tees Valley, and third in the north-east. **In 2016 and 2017 students improved on this further still, with records broken this year again in all key measures for the third year in a row.**

Our 2017 GCSE results for students achieving 9-4 (the new A*-C) in both English and maths were 85%, up 7% on 2016 and now 24% higher than the historical best of 61% when the school was previously judged outstanding by Ofsted. **An incredible 74% achieved 9-5 (the new A*-B) in both English and maths.**

Students learn in a studious, hard-working yet warm and friendly community. We are particularly proud of how polite, helpful and supportive students are of each other, in and out of lessons, and how hard they work on key workplace skills such as resilience, confidence, commitment and team-work. Come and see this for yourself!
