Year 10 GCSE Geography visits to Middlesbrough and Redcar – Wednesday 26 June and Monday 1 July.

The Geography Department has organised visits to Middlesbrough and Redcar. These important visits form part of their investigations into Human and Physical Geography. In Middlesbrough students will analyse different aspects of housing and land use in urban areas. In Redcar students will examine a variety of coastal features. The data collected on this visit will be used to prepare students for their examinations in the summer of 2020.

The visits will take place for all Year 10 GCSE geography students as follows:-

Wednesday 26 June Middlesbrough

Monday 1 July Redcar

Transport has been arranged, the cost of which has been covered by the Academy. Students will leave school at 9am and return at approximately 12.30pm on each day. Students will spend the afternoon on each day with their geography teacher completing follow-up work from the visits. Please complete and return the reply slip below, no later than **Monday 17 June 2019**.

Students do not need to wear their school uniform but should be dressed sensibly for the day. They should also bring a waterproof jacket with them. They must also ensure they are fully equipped with a pen, pencil and ruler to help with the collection of data; a clipboard would also be useful.

A packed lunch will need to be taken by students. Please note that fizzy and energy type drinks should not be taken on the trip. Students who are entitled to free school meals will receive a packed lunch from the dining hall.
