Please note: only uniform purchased from online uniform supplier 'Trutex' or Bambinis in Guisborough is permitted in the Academy. Alternatives with the badge embroidered on are not permitted.

THE ACADEMY UNIFORM

Required Academy Uniform

Academy long or short sleeved shirt - white
Academy trousers or skirt - black
Academy clip-on tie
Academy jacket - black
Plain black socks

Optional Academy Uniform

Academy V neck jumper
Academy V neck slip (tank top)

Required PE Uniform

Purple Academy polo top
Purple/black Academy reversible games top
Academy shorts or Tracksuit bottoms
Plain black knee length games socks
Trainers - no dark coloured soles
Football boots



Optional PE Uniform

Academy tracksuit top
Academy tracksuit bottoms
Gum shield - for rugby/hockey
Shin pads - for rugby/hockey

Drama/Dance - Girls

Plain black leggings
Purple Academy polo top
Black leotard - optional
Slipper socks with grips/indoor shoes

Drama/Dance - Boys

Academy tracksuit bottoms or plain black tracksuit bottoms
Purple Academy polo top
Slipper socks with grips/indoor shoes

Outdoor Coats

Outdoor coats should be dark in colour, e.g. black or navy and should have no large logos. Please note, hoodies are not allowed. Coats must be worn over the school blazer and must not be worn inside the building.

Shirts & Jackets

Jackets must be worn with the sleeves down. Sleeves on shirts or jackets must not be rolled up at any time.

Shoes

Only plain black shoes that are capable of being polished are allowed to be worn with the uniform. No trainers, boots, pumps or canvas shoes will be allowed. Heels should be no higher than 2.5 cm/1 inch.

Bag

Students require a school bag which can fit in an Academy planner and A4 workbooks.

THE ACADEMY UNIFORM

<p>Tights</p> <p>If girls choose to wear a skirt, tights must be worn. Tights must be plain black (not patterned) and a minimum of 40 denier.</p>	<p>Jewellery</p> <p>No jewellery is allowed except a wrist watch and a Medic Alert necklace or bracelet. If any student is thinking about having their ears pierced, this should be done at the start of the summer holidays, as no student will be allowed to wear earrings.</p>
<p>Nail Polish</p> <p>Nail polish is not allowed.</p>	<p>Makeup</p> <p>No makeup should be worn. Students will be asked to remove any makeup that is seen. Concealer for skin conditions is acceptable if discrete.</p>
<p>Hairstyles</p> <p>Please change this to read: Hairstyles should be sensible, with natural colours only. No offensive patterns or styles should be shaved into hairstyles. Hair accessories should be discreet and in black or purple, no scarves or bandanas (unless for religious reasons).</p>	<p>Other Equipment</p> <p>Each student will require a cotton apron for Design and Technology. The apron should be non-plastic and non-offensive, and can be purchased from high street stores.</p> <p>All students will need a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, and a pair of in-ear headphones for languages. A scientific calculator, such as Casio fx-83, a pair of compasses, a protractor and a dictionary would also be useful.</p>

Please note: Students will not be reminded of our uniform policy and will be issued with a consequence if it is not adhered to at all times.

All students in years 7-11 are required to wear the correct Academy uniform. Jackets must be worn, with shirts tucked in, at ALL TIMES. Academy jumpers can be worn under the jacket. In classes, Academy jackets can be removed with the approval of the class teacher. Any student who does not wear the uniform correctly will be issued with a C4 detention.

Any items of clothing, jewellery or hair accessories that do not adhere to the above policy will be confiscated and a C4 will be issued. Parents/carers may wish to collect these items at the end of the Academy day.

The uniform rule is simple: wear the uniform, and wear it correctly.

NB: The final decision with regard to all issues relating to uniform will be made by the Principal.
